

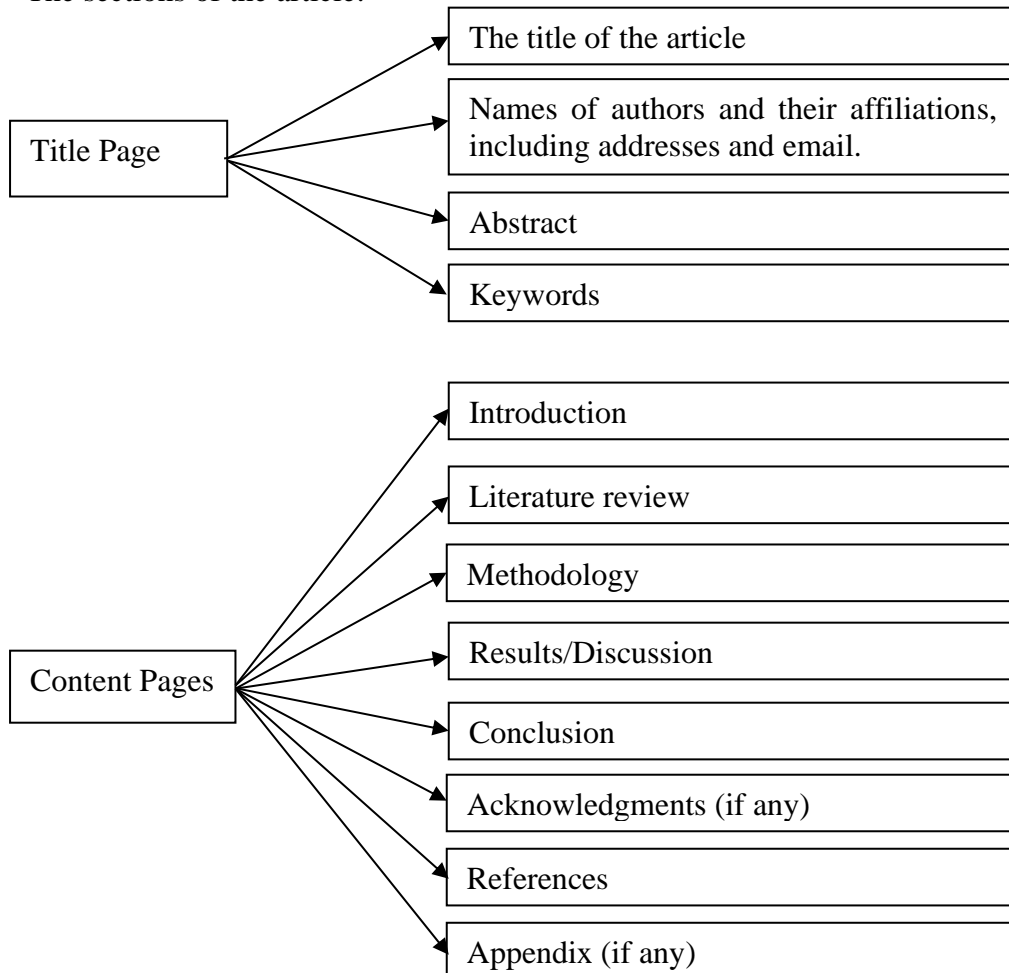
ARTICLE FORMAT INTRODUCTIONS

Recommendation: The authors can use the template (download [here](#)) to format the text. The authors can type their article directly into the template or copy it from another document and paste it (choose Paste Special and Unformatted Unicode Text) in the appropriate position in the template to keep the text format.

The authors should present a list of acknowledgments at the end. Any financial or nonfinancial support for the study should be acknowledged.

REFERENCES

The authors must ensure that all sources are appropriately cited and listed in the reference section. The authors are required to use the APA (American Psychological Association) 7th edition format for citations and references.

1.1. Title of the paper (Use style “Page Title” in the template)

- Font style: Bold, All capitalized
- Size: 14
- Alignment: Center

1.2. Author’s names (Use style “Author” in the template)

Vietnamese authors should write their names in Vietnamese order and with tone marks.

- Font style: Bold
- Size: 10
- Alignment: Center

1.3. Author affiliations (Use style “Affiliation” in the template)

Please provide your affiliation, address, city/province, and nation. Provide the email address of the corresponding author.

- Font style: Italic
- Size: 10
- Alignment: Center

2.5. *Figure (Use style “Figure” in the template)*

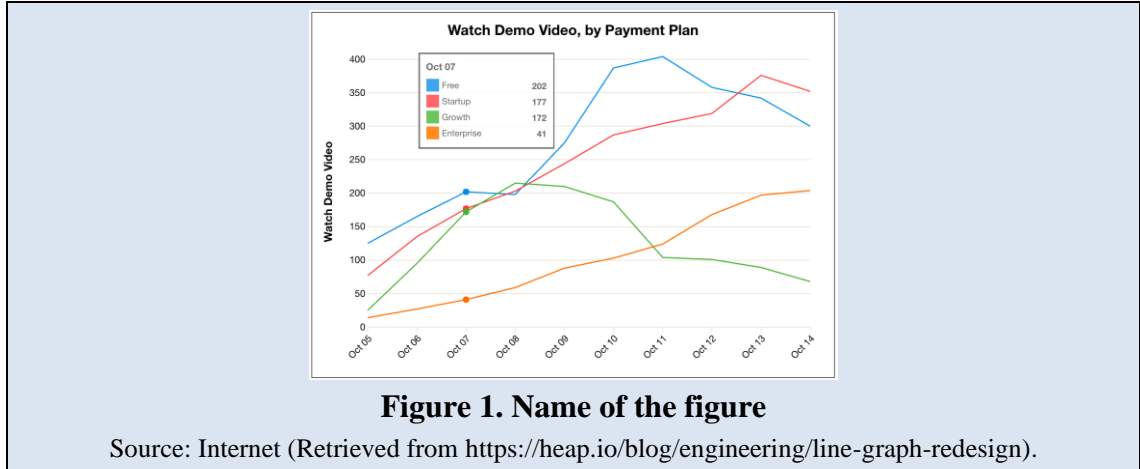
All drawings, pictures, boxes, diagrams, charts, maps, flowcharts, algorithms (not pseudo-code), etc., must be presented as figures.

- Alignment of Figures: Center

- The title of the Figure: The figure title should be placed below the figure (*Use style “Figure Note or Figure No Note” in the template*)

- Font style: Bold
- Size: 12
- Alignment: Center

2.6. Note/Source* (*Use style “Source” in the template*)

*Use for both the note and source of tables and figures. Cite the source (according to APA 7th edition) when necessary.

- Font style: Regular
- Size: 10
- Alignment: Center

2.7. Equation

Equations must be compiled using the Insert / Object / Microsoft Equation 3.0 function in Microsoft Word (or add-ins with features similar to MathType).

Indent: 1.27 cm

The equations must be numbered. The numbers must be right-aligned and properly referenced in the text, such as: “by substituting Equation (1) into Equation (3), we have the general Equation (4), as follows”

$$V = \sum_{t=1}^{n_1} \frac{CF_t}{(1+k)^t} + \sum_{t=n_1+1}^{n_2} \frac{CF_t}{(1+k)^t} + \frac{CF_{n_2+1}}{(k-g)(1+k)^n} \quad (4)$$

2.8. References and Citations (*Use style “Reference” in the template*)

All references and citations must follow the APA (American Psychological Association) 7th edition format. **If a DOI (digital object identifier) is available for an article, always include it.** Please click [here](#) to find DOI. [However, the authors need to check if the DOI is correct before copying it].
